

Q fever program 2023

If you're enrolled in a program or course working with animals or in agricultural environments, you need to provide The University of Queensland (UQ) with evidence of vaccination or immunity against Q fever.

UQ Health Care runs a Q fever screening and vaccination program for **commencing international students** at the start of Semester 1.

The program consists of two visits, one week apart.

- **First visit** - a detailed history, skin test and blood test are performed
- **Second visit, one week later** - tests are read and Q fever vaccine is given if tests show no immunity to Q fever

You must attend both sessions in the program you choose to attend.

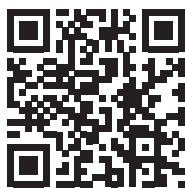

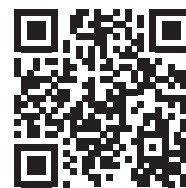
